

Questions and Comments Concerning the Project to Build Four Depots for Products Covered by Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR), Scrap Tires and Hazardous Household Waste (HHW) in Akulivik, Ivujivik, Aupaluk and Tasiujaq, by the Kativik Regional Government Ref. #: 3215-16-065

- QC-1: To the extent that data is available, the Commission is asking the proponent to provide with an assessment of the two pilot projects that took place in the Northern Villages of Kangigsujuaq and Kangigsualujjuaq. Depending on the data available, the proponent must include an estimate of the quantities of the various categories of residual materials recovered, stored and shipped off-site.
- QC-2: The Commission is asking the proponent to provide its action plan in the event of an accidental spill of hazardous materials. The latter must provide for the training of people assigned to residual materials management.
- QC-3: The Commission is asking the proponent to indicate how it will operate the various sites so that incompatible residual hazardous materials are stored in different areas and containers, in accordance with Section 41 of the Regulation Respecting Hazardous Materials.
- QC-4: The Commission has received conflicting information on pilot projects. For example, the preliminary information form indicates under a photo that it is the Kangiqsujuaq site, whereas it would appear to be the Kangiqsualujjuaq site. The Commission therefore asks the proponent to clarify which communities have actually participated in the pilot project and which communities are participating in this project.
